Severe Weather Statement

Snow and Ice

The Shrubbery School stays open in severe weather for staff and pupils who can safely make their way to the school.

In the rare event of extreme severe weather parents would be informed of closure.

As you will be aware, we use a text messaging service through a provider as a way of getting urgent messages to our parents. In the event of any school emergency closure, a text message will be sent to the mobile number on your child's contact form that you have provided. It is therefore vital we are informed of any numbers that are changed in case of any such emergency.

School attendance statistics

Where children are unable to get to school due to severe weather conditions, they can be marked in the register using absence code Y. This means your child's attendance record will not be affected.

If weather deteriorates during the day parents can arrange to pick children up from school before the end of the school day.

Shrubs Club

In the event of severe weather we cannot guarantee that Shrubs Club will continue to function and parents will be texted if this is the case.

The school timetable in severe weather

It may be the case that with teacher absence in severe weather we will not be in a position to run the usual timetable for every child. We will of course ensure learning opportunities are provided.

Please provide named outdoor boots or wellingtons for the day with the warm Shrubbery hat and gloves. We always try and ensure some outdoor play is enabled but children will need a change of footwear.

In hot weather please make sure your child has sun tan cream applied before school and a named sunhat should be provided (plain royal blue) Drinks should be provided or a named drinks bottle. Children have access to water in school.
